

GUIDELINES FOR CHIROPRACTOR LICENSURE WITHIN DHCC

An applicant for licensure to practice as a chiropractor in the DHCC must meet the following requirements in order to qualify for licensure:

OPTION ONE:

- A degree from a chiropractic program accredited by the Councils on Chiropractic Education
- A current license, registration or certificate to practice as a chiropractor in the country, where the applicant trained or practices.
- Successful completion of the national board exams in country of training
- A certificate of good standing from each country where the applicant has held or currently holds a license to practice
- · 2 years experience in designated field
- English proficiency programs, if the language of instruction of the chiropractor program is not in English
- Favorable references

OPTION TWO:

- A degree from a chiropractic program
- A current license, registration or certificate to practice as a chiropractor in the country, where the applicant trained or practices.
- A certificate of good standing from each country where the applicant has held or currently holds a license to practice
- Certificate of Attainment from the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners (NBCE)
- 2 years experience in designated field
- English proficiency programs, if the language of instruction of the chiropractor program is not in English
- · Favorable references
