

## GUIDELINES FOR RADIOLOGICAL TECHNOLOGIST LICENSURE

An applicant for licensure in radiology technology or related field in the DHCC must meet the following requirements in order to qualify for licensure:

### **Radiology Technology:**

- High school graduate (accredited) or equivalency of a high school certificate
- Bachelor degree in a radiology or medical imaging program  
**Or** Diploma (minimum 3 yrs in length)
- A current license, registration or certificate to practice
- Demonstrated proof of a license from the applicant's country of education
- A certificate of good standing from each country where the applicant has held or currently holds a license to practice
- 2 years experience in designated field
- English proficiency programs, if the language of instruction of the medical imaging program is not in English
- Favorable references

### **Ultrasonographer**

- High school graduate (accredited) or equivalency of a high school certificate
- Bachelors degree in related field
- Post- graduate course of study/qualification in the specialty of ultrasound/sonography  
**OR**
- A bachelor's degree in Ultrasound
- A current license, registration or certificate to practice
- Demonstrated proof of a license from the applicant's country of education
- A certificate of good standing from each country where the applicant has held or currently holds a license to practice
- 2 years experience in designated field
- English proficiency programs, if the language of instruction of the ultrasound/sonography program is not in English
- Favorable references
