	Provide equipment to measure the temperature of customers,

	session. Anyone with a temperature of over 37.5 degrees shall not be
	allowed in the facility.
	•. Individuals below the age of 12 and above 60 are not allowed to
	practice activities.
	A person who has a cough, temperature, breathing difficulty,
	respiratory disease or immunodeficiency, shall not be allowed to
	participate in the sports activities.
	Guidelines and instructions issued by health authorities, and updated
	from time to time, shall be observed and strictly followed.
	The return of activity does not include swimming and water sports
	centers that are practiced indoor, and the return of the activity in them

	All elevators must have markings on the floor that indicate social

Services	Use of disposable covers for the seats and steering wheels
	Undergo mandatory temperature screening and staff showing

	Each valet station to have sanitizing wipes that are used to wipe down
	the steering wheel, gear stick, and any other surface touched (e.g. key

	Valet attendant to keep the AC on for some time before delivering the
	car back to the guests (while keeping the doors and windows open) to
	achieve right amount of fresh air/air circulation. Valet attendant can also
	use fogging sanitation or special strong fans for ventilation purposes.
